The bell is rung, then the Priest says, softly:

○ In the name... Our Father... Rejoice, Mary... (p. 1)

The Priest sings with a full voice, signing his forehead:

∿ **O God, O be attentive unto helping me.** (Ps. 69:1)

℞ **O Lord, make haste to help me. O Glory be to the Father and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, and now and always, and unto the ages of ages. Amen. Alleluia.**

(From Septuagesima to Pascha, in lieu of 'alleluya' is sung, 'Praise be to Thee, O Lord, King of eternal glory.')
