

PSALM TONE INVITATORY ANTIPHONS FOR TONE II.

Advent. Our King and Saviour draweth · nigh; * O come, let us · adore him.

Christmastide. Alleluia. Unto us a Child is · born; * O come, let us adore him. Al·leluia.

Epiphanytide and Transfiguration. The Lord hath manifested forth his · glory; * O come, let us · adore him.

Lent. The Master calleth not the righteous but sinners to re·pentance; * O come, let us · adore him.

Eastertide. Alleluia. The Lord is risen in·deed; * O come, let us adore him. Al·leluia.

Ascensiontide. Alleluia. Christ the Lord ascendeth into · heaven; * O come, let us adore him. Al·leluia.

Whitsuntide. Alleluia. The Spirit of the Lord filleth the · world; * O come, let us adore him. Al·leluia.

Trinitytide. Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, one · God; * O come, let us · adore him.

Purification and Annunciation. The Word was made flesh, and dwelt a·mong us; * O come, let us · adore him.

Any Saint's Day. The Lord is glorious in his · Saints; * O come, let us · adore him.

PROPER CHRISTMASTIDE INVITATORY ANTIPHON FOR TONE II.

Psalm 95 *Venite, exultemus Domino* Tone II 1

○ COME let us sing unto the · LORD; * let us heartily rejoice in the strength of our · salvation.

2 Let us come before his presence with thanks-giving; * and show ourselves glad · in him with psalms. *Antiphon.*

3 For the LORD is a great · God; * and a great King · above all gods.

4 In his hand are all the corners of the · earth; * and the strength of the hills is · his also.

5 The sea is his and he · made it; * and his hands prepar-ed · the dry land. *Antiphon.*

6 [*Genuflect*] O come let us worship and fall · down, * and kneel before the LORD · our Maker. [*Rise*]

7 For he is the Lord our · God; * and we are the people of his pas-ture and the sheep · of his hand. *Antiphon.*

FIRST ENDING.

8 O worship the LORD in the beauty of · holiness; * let the whole earth stand · in awe of him.

9 For he cometh, for he cometh to judge the · earth; * and with righteousness to judge the world and the peo-ples with his truth. *Antiphon.*

10 Glory be to the Father and to the · Son, * and to · the Holy Ghost;

11 As it was in the beginning, † is now and ever · shall be, * world with-out end. Amen. *Antiphon.*

SECOND ENDING.

8 To-day if ye will hear his voice harden not your · hearts * as in the provocation and as in the day of temptation in · the wilderness;

9 When your fathers · tempted me, * prov-ed me · and saw my works.

10 Forty years long was I griev-ed with this generation and · said, * It is a people that do err in their hearts for they have · not known my ways.

11 Unto whom I swear in my · wrath, * that they should not enter in-to my rest. *Antiphon.*
